

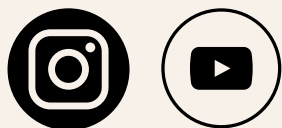

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Biography

Rosemarie Gauthier is a singer-songwriter with pop/folk influences, originally from Lévis. Self-taught and a lifelong music enthusiast, she began performing on stage in 2022, accompanying herself on guitar in restaurants and pubs throughout the region. Over the years, her passion for songwriting has continued to grow.

Armed with her guitar, she took to the stage of La Voix in 2024, as part of Roxane Bruneau's team, and reached the qualifying stage. This experience gave her the confidence to share her own works. She did so for the first time during her show at the Festival Outaouais en fête in June 2024, where she preceded Andréanne A. Malette and Daniel Bélanger.

She continued to develop as an artist and prove herself during her participation in the 56th edition of the Granby International Song Festival in 2024. She continued her momentum by being selected for the Ma Première Place des Arts competition in the fall of the same year, where she performed four of her songs at the Claude-Léveillée hall, in front of an audience and jury.

At the same time, she is working on recording her first EP, which is scheduled for release in the fall of 2025. Her first single, titled "Eau de rose," was released on February 14. "Petites heures," the second single from the EP, was released in April.

Artistic approach

Her creative process remains very intimate to this day, and her creative impulses are marked by an intuitive spontaneity: alone with her thoughts and her guitar, the central instrument of her expression. Her lyrics explore love in all its forms and are rooted in her deep need to connect with others. Combining poetry and modernity, her music navigates between folk song and pop influences.
